General eligibility criteria

- Meet the admission requirements of the program you have been admitted to.
- Be enrolled full-time in Université de Sudbury undergraduate program.
- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident or have protected person or refugee status (unless otherwise indicated).

Admission Scholarships (*automatic*) **\$12,000**

The Université de Sudbury's Admission Scholarship automatically provides all eligible full-time students \$3,000 per year (\$12,000 total). This scholarship reflects our commitment to making higher education more accessible for all students, ensuring that financial barriers to pursuing your academic and career goals are reduced.

This scholarship is awarded to every committed student, pursuing a full-time degree at uSudbury. No application is required.

Team Player Scholarships **\$3,000**

To be considered for this scholarship, a teacher, principal, or guidance counsellor must nominate the student through a letter highlighting how they have demonstrated either:

- high academic achievement
- academic improvement
- teamwork, problem-solving skills, and creativity through their involvement in sports teams, clubs, community volunteer work or other extracurricular activities

Sudbury Bound Scholarships \$2,000

Students moving to uSudbury can receive an additional \$2,000 scholarship towards their uSudbury residence costs.

Quantity is limited. This scholarship is available to a full-time uSudbury student, at a first come, first serve basis.

Indigenous Student Scholarships \$3,000

Awarded to any full-time uSudbury student from M'Chigeeng, Aundeck Omni Kaning, Wikwemikong, Sheguiandah, and Sheshegwaning First Nations. The student must demonstrate strong academic performance and community involvement.
